[general information]

The website green-cat.eu (hereinafter: 'Website') is operated by Dominik Dulik Green Cat with the registered office in Krakow, ul. Skotnicka 177, loc. 1/1, 30-394 Krakow, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs, Tax Identification Number: 6831812235, Business Identification Number: 356775053, e-mail office@green- cat.eu (hereinafter: 'Administrator').

As part of the activities of the Website, data of the Website users (hereinafter: "Users"), including personal data, may be collected and processed.

The entity placing cookies on the Website User's end device and accessing them is the Website Operator Dominik Dulik Green Cat with registered office in Kraków, ul. Skotnicka 177, room 1/1, 30-394 Kraków

User data may be collected as a result of: their voluntary provision by the Users, use of cookies and the Administrator's use of the tools described below.

Moreover, information about the User's IP address, the time of sending a request and response, the address of the website from which the User was redirected to the Website and the type of software used by the User may be collected. This information is used for the purposes of administering the Website and compiling statistics and analyses.

§ 2

[personal data]

The Administrator of the Users' personal data is Dominik Dulik Green Cat with the registered office in Kraków, ul. Skotnicka 177, loc. 1/1, 30-394 Kraków, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs, with NIP number: 6831812235, REGON number: 356775053, e-mail: biuro@green-cat.eu.

The Administrator via the Website may collect and subsequently process personal data for purposes such as

contacting the User, providing the User with commercial information via e-mail or telephone, statistics and analysis of User behaviour on the website.

The Administrator may make User data available to its subcontractors (entities whose services it uses for processing) such as IT service and solution providers or IT service providers.

The personal data are processed for the period which is indicated to the User in each case in the relevant information provided at the time of data collection. In the case of data processed for the purpose of statistics and analysis of User behaviour on the website and contact with the User, the Administrator may process the data for a period of 3 years from the date of their collection.

The User who is the subject of the data has the following rights:

the right to access the personal data and the right to receive a copy thereof;

the right to rectify the personal data;

the right to erasure of personal data;

the right to request restriction of processing of personal data;

the right to request a copy of the data;

the right to personal data portability;

the right to object to the processing of personal data;

the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

When processing data, the Controller may use entities that have their registered office in the USA. As a result, there may be a transfer of personal data outside the European Economic Area. The Controller shall only use entities that belong to the EU-US Privacy Shield programme and provide an adequate level of data protection.

Where processing is based on consent, the Data Subject shall also have the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

§ 3

[cookies and tools used on the websites]

As part of the activities of the Website, cookies stored in the Users' terminal equipment are used. The use of cookies shall be understood as storing and accessing them by the Administrator.

Cookies are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored in the User's terminal equipment and are intended for use on the Website. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, the time they are stored on the terminal equipment, content (e.g. action identifiers) and a unique number.

Cookies are used for:

adapting the content of the Website to the User's preferences and optimising the use of the Website. In particular, these files allow for recognition of the User's device and for proper display of the Website, adjusting it to his needs and preferences;

to create statistics and analyses concerning the use of the Website;

use of the IT tools referred to in § 4.

The Website uses two main types of cookies: "session" (session cookies, session storage) and "permanent" (persistent cookies, local storage). "Session" cookies are temporary files that are stored in the User's terminal equipment until the session expires (e.g. leaving the Website, deleting them by the User, or switching off the software). "Permanent" cookies are stored in the User's end device for the time specified in the parameters of cookies or until they are deleted by the User.

The use of cookies does not cause any configuration changes in the User's final device and the software installed on that device.

The default settings of Internet browsers usually allow the storage of cookies on the end device of the users of websites. However, these settings can be changed by the User.

The User has the possibility to determine the conditions of using cookies through the settings of the software (web browser) installed on his/her end device. The change may consist in partial or complete restriction of the possibility of saving cookies on the user's terminal device.

The Administrator informs that according to the provisions of the Telecommunications Law, the consent of the end user to store information or to gain access to information already stored in the telecommunications end user's device can be expressed by the user also by means of software settings installed in the end user's device. Therefore, in the event that the user does not wish to give such consent, they should change their browser settings.

[IT tools used]

The Administrator uses the Google Analytics tool provided by Google LLC, which is based in the USA and therefore outside the European Economic Area. Google LLC is an entity which has joined the EU-US Privacy Shield programme and ensures an adequate level of data protection. This tool is used to analyse website statistics.

The Administrator uses Facebook Pixel, which is an analytical tool that helps measure the effectiveness of advertisements on the basis of analysis of actions taken by the Users on the website, which consequently enables running more effective advertising campaigns.
